INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Thank you for participating in the “Lamprey Hunters” program! Your data will help in the effort to control the destructive sea lamprey. We appreciate your interest in being a part of the solution to this serious problem.

Participation in this program is voluntary. To become a lamprey hunter, you must register and participate in a short training exercise. Training will occur via one of three methods: 1) during fishing club meetings, 2) online during the registration process, or 3) at special training workshops.

TO REGISTER AND TRAIN

1. Visit www.glfc.org/lampreyhunters
2. Click on “login and submit data” and then select the “First time user?” link.
3. Select whether you have or have not gone through a training exercise. (You will have the option to skip the online training exercise if you participated in a training workshop or a meeting.)
4. If you have not participated in a training workshop or a meeting, follow the 10-minute training exercise. **Note:** you will be asked to register after this training exercise. Please do not begin the exercise unless you have the time to complete it.
5. Fill out the registration form at the end of the training exercise. You will then be given a password. You can change your password the next time you login. To change your password:
 - a. Be logged out
 - b. Click on “login and submit data”
 - c. Click on the “change your password” link.

TO RECORD AND SUBMIT DATA

1. Download the “**boat tally sheet**” and the “**data form**,” both available at www.glfc.org/lampreyhunters, then by clicking on “forms and instructions.”
2. Go fishing!
3. On your **boat tally sheet**, keep track of the species caught and note any sea lamprey wounds. (Remember, it is important to record data even if there are no sea lamprey wounds.)
4. After returning to port, at your leisure, record the data from your trip on the multi-trip **data form**.
5. Visit www.glfc.org/lampreyhunters and click on “login and submit your data.”
6. Log in.
7. Enter the data from the data form into the online database in the fields provided. Data can be entered after each trip or tallied for several trips during a two-week period (maximum).
